Mergers and acquisitions and private equity investment have reached record levels in recent years, while government initiatives, Brazil's hosting of the World Cup in 2014 and the Rio Olympics in 2016, are having a significant impact on infrastructure and related investments.

Brazil is, however, currently experiencing an economic slowdown, with a number of major companies suffering an investment downgrade in recent months. The sectors particularly affected are infrastructure, oil and gas, power and telecoms. This, coupled with the fact that a significant proportion of investment in those sectors has come from international investors means that understanding the Brazilian restructuring landscape is now critical for those interested in cross-border transactions involving Brazilian companies or assets located in Brazil.

The seminar will focus on the restructuring regime in Brazil and how it differs from those in the US and Europe, in particular its challenges and opportunities (Distressed M&A) for international investors. There will be an opportunity to consider some recent cases, including certain aspects of the EBX group in which both firms have been involved.
